Pauli Murray and the 14th Amendment - Pauli Murray

was a visionary. She was the first person to realize that the 1896 *Plessy v. Ferguson* Supreme Court decision which ensconced Jim Crow Laws and customs into life in the South, ignored the mandates of the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment. This led to almost seventy years of social injustice toward blacks through the Jim Crow era. Even though her writings were used to win the landmark *Brown v. Board of Education* decision which desegregated schools, Murray never received that credit—she was only a woman after all. The presentation shines the spotlight on current events like voter suppression, women's right to reproductive choice, rights to gay marriage which are all examples in which the mandates of the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment are in play, and, in the case of Roe v. Wade, have once again been ignored. The presentation emphasizes the need to vote and protect voting rights so that all other human rights can be protected. (Grades 9-12) (45 min. inc. Questions)
