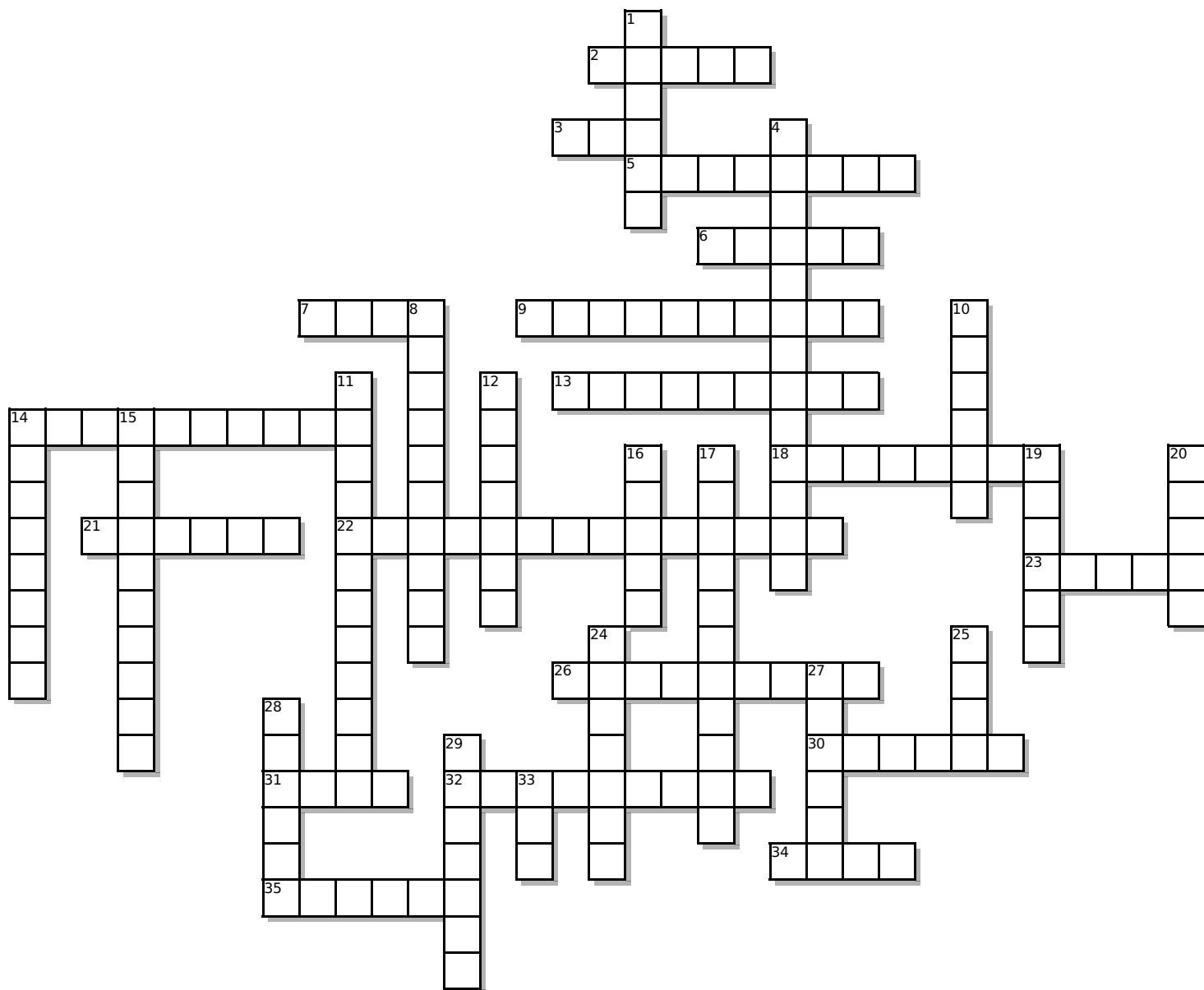


# Volcano Crossword

### ACROSS
